

International Roaming Packages



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International roaming by qualified Public Safety Entities and their Authorized Users outside of Canada, Mexico and the Pacific Territories (American Samoa, Guam and the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands) requires the purchase of an international roaming package*. International roaming locations are extensive, and additional roaming locations will be supported in the future. The list of included destinations for each package can be found at www.firstnet.com/intlcountries.

*The packages described in this brochure require a FirstNet Capable device provisioned with a FirstNet Trio Subscriber Identification Module (SIM) card for use on the FirstNet Evolved Packet Core. If you have a device provisioned with an AT&T SIM card for use on the AT&T commercial core, please see att.com/global for available international roaming packages.

INTERNATIONAL DAILY PASS AND INTERNATIONAL DAILY PASS - MULTILINE

Pay a low daily fee to use data, talk, and text from your domestic FirstNet Mobile plan when roaming in select countries. Just add it once to make it available whenever you travel in included countries and then pay just a daily fee only on the days you use your device.

INTERNATIONAL ROAMING PACKAGES: Eligibility: Available only to qualified Public Safety Entities that have a valid agreement with AT&T for the FirstNet Solution ("Qualified Agreement") and their authorized Agency Paid Users and, (with the exception of the AT&T Business PassportSM package), Subscriber Paid Users. Requires a 4G LTE-compatible, FirstNet Capable device provisioned with a FirstNet Trio SIM card and a qualified FirstNet Mobile plan for domestic use on the FirstNet Evolved Packet Core. If you have a device provisioned with an AT&T SIM card for domestic use on the AT&T commercial core, please see att.com/globalcountries for available international roaming destinations. For Subscriber Paid Users, certain additional eligibility restrictions apply which may be based on service tenure, payment history and/or credit. AT&T, in its sole discretion, may block your ability to use your device while roaming internationally until eligibility criteria are met. Availability and quality of coverage and services while roaming are not guaranteed.

INTERNATIONAL DAILY PASS (IDP): Eligible domestic FirstNet Mobile postpaid wireless plan required. Provisioning: Must be provisioned on a per-device basis before use. You can add IDP to your device before travel or, for non-government customers only, AT&T will automatically add IDP to the line if (i) you have not added IDP and do not have another international feature on the line; (ii) the line uses an eligible smartphone, tablet, mobile hotspot device or laptop while traveling in an IDP destination not included in your domestic rate plan, and (iii) the line incurs at least 5MB in international data roaming usage at pay-per-use rates (see att.com/intlpprates). If we add IDP to a line, we will send you an email and/or a SMS to the line. Once added to your device, International Daily Pass will stay on your account until you remove it at <https://localcontrol.firstnet.att.com> or call 800.574.7000 or dial 611 from your AT&T mobile phone. **Use and Assessment of Fee:** Once you add this option to your device, the first time you use data or voice, or send a text message in an International Daily Pass destination, you'll automatically be charged a \$10 daily fee. The fee covers additional data, voice or text messages sent for 24 hours from the initial use in any International Daily Pass destination during that period. You'll be charged an additional \$10 fee for all subsequent 24-hour periods in which you use data or voice or send a text message on a device set up with International Daily Pass in an International Daily Pass destination until you cancel the service. For a list of included destinations, go to www.firstnet.com/intlcountries. **Incidental Data Usage: Apps on your device continue to use data even when you may not be aware of the usage. Such incidental data usage may trigger the \$10 daily fee. To avoid unintended use of International Daily Pass, turn off the roaming feature for your smartphone or device.** **Billing:** Your International Daily Pass data and voice usage will generally be applied to the monthly bill period/data amount of your domestic plan at the time it's used. However, because of the way we receive reporting from our international roaming carriers, voice or data usage may not match your exact dates of travel, and voice or data usage may be applied to your subsequent bill period. **Data:** International Daily Pass lets you use data in all included International Daily Pass destinations without roaming charges. Data will be drawn from your domestic plan allowance. Additional or promotional data may not be available for use in destinations outside the U.S. Actual data speeds vary by device and location. **Data Overage:** If you go over the amount of data in your qualified plan or other allowances during your bill period, overage charges will apply. **Voice:** For phones. International Daily Pass allows you to use the calling features of your domestic FirstNet Mobile plan within and between included International Daily Pass destinations, from included destinations to the U.S. Calls and minutes of usage will be drawn from your domestic voice plan allowance. You may be charged for calls to special or premium service numbers. **Calls to non-IDP destinations:** Calls from included destinations to non-included destinations will incur International Long Distance (ILD) charges. Per-minute pay-per-use rates apply unless you add an International Long-Distance service package to the device making the calls. Rates subject to change without notice. To see what it costs, go to

International Daily Pass allows you to use the standard messaging features of your FirstNet Mobile domestic plan within and from an included destination. Includes an unlimited number of messages up to 1MB in size within and from an International Daily Pass destination to more than 190 countries for text messages, and more than 120 countries for picture and video messages. We may add, change and remove included destinations at our discretion without notice. Messages sent through applications like iMessage or Hangouts may incur data or other charges. For details, go to att.com/text2world. **Service restrictions:** Only available for use with eligible devices (i.e., smartphones, feature phones (basic/messaging phones) and tablets). International use aboard cruise ships or airlines/flights that are not AeroMobile-enabled is not included; see pay-per-use rates at att.com/intlpprates to review rates. **Canada, Mexico and the Pacific Territories:** You won't be charged the \$10 fee for International Daily Pass in Canada, Mexico or the Pacific Territories, as your domestic FirstNet Mobile plan includes usage in those locations at no additional charge. **Miscellaneous:** For devices with an active International Daily Pass and an International Pass package, International Daily Pass charges will apply in included International Daily Pass destinations even though you also have an International package. Data talk and text from the International Pass package can't be used to avoid voice and data overage charges incurred in International Daily Pass destinations.

INTERNATIONAL DAILY PASS – MULTILINE (IDPM): Eligible domestic FirstNet Mobile – Unlimited Enhanced postpaid wireless plan required. Provisioning: Must be provisioned on a per-device basis before use. Once you add this option to your device, International Daily Pass - Multiline will stay on your account until you remove it at <https://localcontrol.firstnet.att.com> or call 800.574.7000 or dial 611 from your AT&T mobile phone. **Use and Assessment of Fee:** The first time you use data, make or receive a call, or send a text message in an IDPM destination, you'll automatically be charged a daily fee. Text messages received are rated as domestic and do not trigger a daily fee. The fee covers additional data, calls, and text messages for 24 hours from the initial use in any IDPM destination. You'll be charged an additional daily fee for all subsequent 24-hour periods in which you use data, make or receive a call, or send a text message in an IDPM destination, unless you remove IDPM. **Reduced Daily Fee:** The standard daily fee is \$10 per day per line. However, when 5 or fewer lines on your billing account are charged an IDPM daily fee on the same calendar date, 1 of these lines will be charged the standard daily fee of \$10, and up to 4 of these lines will be charged a reduced daily fee of \$5 per line. When 6 or more lines on your billing account are charged an IDPM daily fee on the same calendar date, 4 of these lines will be charged the reduced daily fee of \$5 per line, and the remaining 2 or more lines will be charged the standard daily fee of \$10 per line. Calendar date is determined by your local U.S. time zone, not the destination you visited. The line(s) charged \$10 are not necessarily the line(s) used first on that date. **Destinations:** For a list of IDPM destinations, go to

www.firstnet.com/intlcountries. **Data:** Data will be drawn from your FirstNet Mobile – Unlimited Enhanced plan with the same data and speed restrictions. In addition, if domestic plan includes Stream Saver then also will apply to your International Day Pass for Business – Multiline feature. See att.com/stream saver for more details. If your data speed is slowed, all your data use, including audio and video streaming, picture and video messaging, and other types of data use will be impacted and may not work. **Incidental data usage: Apps on your device use data even when you may not be aware. Such usage may trigger a daily fee. To avoid unintended use of IDPM, turn off cellular data roaming in your device settings.** **Unlimited talk:** For phones only. Includes cellular calls received in IDPM destinations and made from IDPM destinations to the U.S. and to other IDPM destinations. **Calls to non-IDPM destinations:** Calls from IDPM destinations to non-IDPM destinations will get International Long Distance (ILD) charges. Pay-per-use rates apply unless you add an ILD



package to your device. Rates are subject to change without notice. For details, go to att.com/intlcalling. **Unlimited text:** For phones only. Applies only to AT&T Short Messaging Service (SMS) and Multimedia Messaging Service (MMS) and not to other messaging services or applications like iMessage. Messages received are rated as domestic and do not trigger a daily fee. **AT&T Business PassportSM:** For devices with IDPM and an active AT&T Business PassportSM package, IDPM charges will apply in IDPM destinations and usage in IDPM destinations will not reduce the package's data allowance, trigger passport calling charges, or offset the voice allowance. If you want to use Business Passport in an IDPM destination, you must remove IDPM. **Pay-per-use rates:** Apply when traveling in destinations not included in IDPM and/or when you have not added a package. For rates, see att.com/intlpprates. **Service restrictions:** Only available for use with eligible devices (i.e., smartphones, feature phones (basic/messaging phones) and tablets). International use aboard cruise ships and on airlines/flights that are not AeroMobile-enabled is not included. **Canada, Mexico and the Pacific Territories:** You won't be charged the daily fee for International Daily Pass – Multiline in Canada, Mexico or the Pacific Territories, as your domestic FirstNet Mobile – Unlimited Enhanced plan includes usage in those locations at no additional charge. **Miscellaneous:** For devices with an active IDPM and an International package, IDPM charges will apply in included IDPM destinations even though you also have an International package. Data talk and text from the International package can't be used to avoid voice and data overage charges incurred in IDPM destinations.

AT&T BUSINESS PASSPORTSM: **Eligibility:** Business passport is available only to Agency Paid Users. Subscriber Paid Users are ineligible. **Charges:** Monthly-recurring charge applies. Package will not be prorated if canceled on or after the chosen effective date. A package canceled prior to chosen effective date will not incur the one-time charge. Includes talk, text and data allotments for use in select AT&T Passport destinations listed at www.firstnet.com/intlcountries. **Talk:** For phones only. Minute allowance must be used in bill period provided or will be forfeited. **Talk Overage:** If you use all your Business Passport package minutes, \$0.25 per minute charge applies to all cellular calls dialed and accepted in Passport destinations. **Wi-Fi Calling:** With Wi-Fi Calling, you can call back to the U.S. at no additional charge. Calls to other countries, including the country you're in, are included in your Business Passport calling allowance. **Data:** Actual data speeds vary by device and location. If your domestic plan includes Video Management, or reduces video streaming speed, the same will apply to your Business Passport package. Data allowance must be used in bill period provided or will be forfeited. **Overage and Data Speeds:** There is no charge for data overage. **However, if you use all your Business Passport package data, all data usage is slowed to a max of 256Kbps for the rest of the bill cycle.** All data usage will be impacted and may not be fully functional. **Unlimited Text:** For phones only. Applies only to AT&T Short Messaging Service (SMS) and Multimedia Messaging Service (MMS), and not to other messaging services or applications that use data, such as iMessage. Unless you have a domestic plan that includes unlimited text, messages received in Passport destinations are charged at your domestic messaging rates. **Pay-per-use rates:** Apply when package expires, when traveling in destinations not included in Business Passport, and/or when you have not added a package. **Service restrictions:**

CRUISE SHIP PACKAGES Eligibility: Compatible device with eligible domestic postpaid wireless service required. **Charges:** One-time charge of \$60 per line for Cruise Basic package or \$100 per line for Cruise Plus package. Package is valid for 30 days beginning on the chosen effective date, may cross 2 bill cycles, and expires automatically. Package charge will not be prorated if canceled on or after the effective date. If package is canceled prior to the effective date, the line will not be charged. **Coverage:** Package applies to cellular use onboard select cruise ships listed at att.com/cruise when sailing in international waters. When the device is connected to the ship's cellular network, "cellularatsea", "wmsatsea", "901-18" or "NOR-18" displays on the device. The ship turns off its cellular network when it is within 12 nautical miles from land and docked or tendered in port, at which point cellular service is provided via the nearest country. **Countries:** Add an available international roaming package to your domestic wireless plan to cover usage when on land or in port. **Data:** Includes 100MB of data for Cruise Basic package (smartphones only) or 1GB of data for Cruise Plus package (smartphones and tablets only). Actual data speeds vary by device and ship. **Data overage:** If you exceed the amount of data in your Cruise package, additional data will automatically be provided in increments of 100MB for \$10 each. **Once you have incurred \$300 in data overage charges or, for Subscriber Paid Users, \$100 in data overage charges, data use is subject to suspension, including data use on land, even if you have a separate international package for data usage on land.** Upon suspension, AT&T will provide notice and instructions for restoring data use capability. **Talk:** For phones only. Applies to all cellular calls dialed and accepted. Cruise Basic package includes 100 minutes of calling. If you use all your Cruise Basic package calling minutes, additional cellular calls will be charged \$1/minute. Cruise Plus package includes unlimited talk. **Wi-Fi Calling:** With Wi-Fi Calling enabled on eligible devices, you can call back to the U.S. at no additional charge. **Unlimited Text:** For phones only. Applies only to AT&T Short Messaging Service (SMS) and Multimedia Messaging Service (MMS) and not to other messaging services or applications that use data, such as iMessage.
